

La posesión / Possession

There are several ways to show possession in Spanish. One way is to use **possessive adjectives**, like "my" and "your" in English.



mi	my	nuestro/-a	our
tu	your	vuestro/-a	your (pl.)
su	his/her/its/your (form.)	su	their/your (pl.)

Only *nuestro* and *vuestro* change when modifying a feminine noun. The others remain the same. All of these adjectives add an **s** when modifying a plural noun.

- To describe ownership expressed with "'s" in English, use the construction [object] + de + [subject].

Examples: my book *mi libro*
John's book *el libro de John*

Use the contraction "del" in place of de + el. Example: la mano del niño
